Accessing the Teen Council Curriculum and Support Materials - Effective July 1, 2025

You will be able to access all Teen Council curriculum and support materials on the SparkEd.net website with your annual Teen Council subscription renewal. The renewal rate remains the same at \$2,000 per Teen Council.

TC Foundations Training

We will continue to offer Teen Council Foundations Training for new facilitators, using the hybrid training model you are all familiar with. Participants can register and pay for the training on the Learning Management System. The registration rate for Teen Council Foundations will increase to \$1,500 per participant to reflect the cost of providing the 35-hour training program.

TC Foundations training consists of:

- 12 hours of virtual instructor-led training in August 2025 focusing on the basic information and skills of setting up and running the year-long Teen Council program.
 - 15 self-paced modules to be completed between July 2025 June 2026. Modules include:

 Welcome to TC This brief module will introduce you to Teen Council by sharing the history, purpose, and impact of the program.
 - 2. Peer Education Facilitation Model Introduction to one of the Peer Education Facilitation Model.
 - 3. TC Empowerment Model Introduction to the Teen Council model that will help facilitators identify what to prioritize when facilitating.
 - 4. Group Stages of Development This brief module explores the five stages of Teen Council group development.
 - 5. Scope & Sequence This module will help facilitators identify what to think about as they envision the year ahead, and ahead and will guide them in crafting their very own Teen Council scope and sequence.
 - 6. Weekly Meetings & Trainings Weekly meetings are the heart of Teen Council. This three-part module will cover the essential elements related to meetings, how the Peer Ed Facilitation model is reflected during Teen Council trainings, best practices of training, and more.
 - 7. TC Presentations Peer Led Sex Ed: It's the reason most Teen Council members joined Teen Council! What do presentations actually look like? And what does the facilitator *do* while Teen Council members are teaching? This module will answer these questions and more.
 - 8. Peer Education Skills Peer Led Sex Ed: It's the reason most Teen Council members joined Teen Council! What do presentations actually look like? And what does the facilitator *do* while Teen Council members are teaching? This module will answer these questions and more.
 - Feedback Feedback is one of a facilitator's most effective tools for building strong peer educators and connected Teen Council groups. This module will break down the what, when, and how of giving effective feedback to Teen Council members.
 - 10. Navigating Facilitation Challenges Experiencing and navigating the challenges of the Teen Council program takes skill and practice. This module discusses the most common facilitation challenges and offers three helpful steps to resolving these challenges.
 - 11. Recognition & Celebration Teen Council members deserve to be recognized for their contributions and dedication to peer education! This module highlights all the

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celebration-worthy parts of this program and gives loads of ideas for how to honour individual members and the group.

- 12. Recruitment Recruitment is a year-long process. This 2 part module explores the impacts of successful recruitment and covers the essential elements and best practices of recruitment, including how to implement the most effective recruitment strategies in your own community.
- 13. Interviews & Selection There are 9 steps to successful interviews and selection. This 3 part module will describe how to prepare for, execute, and complete the process. By balancing the principles and values with logistical aspects, interviews and selection to be inclusive, warm, and organized.
- 14. Transitions The end of the Teen Council year overlaps with the start of the upcoming group. This module will explore this unique phase of the group process and offer ideas for commemorating one group while welcoming the next.
- 15. Retreat Retreat is the foundation of the Teen Council year! This module will cover the purpose of Teen Council, Important considerations in planning, the essential elements and best practices of retreat, and a sample agenda.

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
